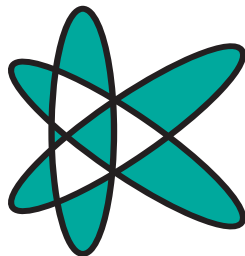

POLL RESULTS OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING HELD ON 21 NOVEMBER 2025

The Board is pleased to announce that all the Proposed Resolutions as set out in the AGM Notice were duly passed by the Shareholders by way of poll at the 2025 AGM.

Reference is made to the circular (the “**Circular**”) of Okura Holdings Limited (the “**Company**”) and the notice (the “**AGM Notice**”) of the annual general meeting of the Company (the “**2025 AGM**”) both dated 23 October 2025. Unless otherwise defined, capitalised terms used in this announcement shall have the same meanings as those defined in the Circular.

The Board is pleased to announce that all the proposed resolutions (the “**Proposed Resolutions**”) as set out in the AGM Notice were duly passed by the Shareholders by way of poll at the 2025 AGM held on Friday, 21 November 2025.

As at the date of the 2025 AGM, there were 600,000,000 issued Shares entitling the Shareholders to attend and vote for or against the Proposed Resolutions at the 2025 AGM. There were no Shares entitling the Shareholders to attend and abstain from voting in favour of the Proposed Resolutions at the 2025 AGM pursuant to Rule 13.40 of the Listing Rules.

None of the Shareholders were required under the Listing Rules to abstain from voting on the Proposed Resolutions at the 2025 AGM. None of the Shareholders have stated in the Circular their intention to vote against or to abstain from voting on any of the Proposed Resolutions at the 2025 AGM.

Tricor Investor Services Limited, the Company's Hong Kong Share Registrar, was appointed and acted as the scrutineer for the vote-taking at the 2025 AGM.

All Directors (except for Ms. Mariko Yamamoto and Mr. Yuji Matsuzaki who were unable to attend due to other work commitment) have attended the 2025 AGM by electronic means.

As more than 50% of the votes were cast in favour of each of the Proposed Resolutions, no. 1 to no. 7, these resolutions were duly passed as ordinary resolutions of the Company.

As more than 75% of the total votes were cast in favour of Proposed Resolution no. 8, the resolution was duly passed as a special resolution of the Company.
